

Date Jidaimura Noboribetsu: http://edo-trip.jp/

Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura is a history theme park highlighting the Edo Period, one of the most attractive eras in Japanese history. Step back in time to enjoy traditional games, activities, theaters, street performances and more. The charm of ancient Japan is abundant as you mingle with the Ninja and Oiran courtesans.

Noboribetsu Marine Park Nixe is a popular theme park focusing on fish, marine mammals, sea creatures and some other animals. It is combination Danish theme park and aquarium, located near Noboribetsu Station. The aquarium, one of the largest in northern Japan, is in Castle Nixe, modeled after a Danish castle.

Noboribetsu Bear Park is a very popular sightseeing spot on the 550 m above sea level mountaintop of Shihorei (commonly called Kuma-yama meaning bear mountain), which is located southeast of Noboribetsu Hot Spring, one the most famous hot spring villages in Japan.

Jigokudani is a spectacular, appropriately named valley just above the town of Noboribetsu Onsen, which displays hot steam vents, sulfurous streams and other volcanic activity. It is a main source of Noboribetsu's hot spring waters. From the valley, there are attractive walking trails through the wooded hills.

Onuma Park is located about a 40-minute drive from one of Hokkaido's most prominent tourist spots, Hakodate. The easily-accessible Onuma Park can also be reached by train within 50 minutes. Including beautiful flowers and birds during the spring, lush greenery in summer, crimson foliage in autumn, and graceful snow scape in winter.

Hakodate Asaichi (Morning Market) boasts approximately 250 stores offering take-home souvenirs, in particular, seafood products. Try the mouth-watering "seafood rice bowl" here to start your day with a bowl of steaming rice topped with freshly-caught seafood.

Visitors can enjoy viewing Japan's first western-style pentagram castle named Goryokaku, designated as a specialhistorical site from the two-story observation platform of Goryokaku Tower, which stands 107 meters tall. The city of Hakodate, Mt. Hakodate and the beautiful Yokotsu Mountain Bange can also be seen from the platform

Mount Hakodate is a 334 meter high, wooded mountain at the southern end of the peninsula on which much of central Hakodate is located. On clear days and nights, in particular, the views from the mountain are spectacular and included among Japan's three best night views alongside the views.

Accompanied by earthquakes, the mountain suddenly rose from a flat wheat field to its current height of 290 meters between 1943 and 1945. The mountain was named according to the contemporary reign of Emperor Showa. You can get good views of the young volcano by taking the Usuzan Ropeway.

Otaru Canal was a central part of the city's busy port in the first half of the 20th century. Large vessels were unloaded by smaller ships, which then transported the goods to warehouses along the canal.

Each of the buildings can be appreciated in their own right for their elegant western-influenced Meiji-era architecture, unique histories, and the different wares they offer.
